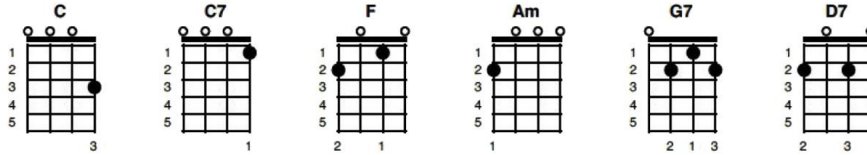


AMAZING GRACE : $\frac{3}{4}$ Time signature (Count "1-2-3 1-2-3 ...)

1st time: play using whole notes (whole notes get 3 counts)

2nd time: play using $\frac{1}{4}$ notes (strum 1-2-3 1-2-3) three $\frac{1}{4}$ notes = $\frac{3}{4}$ time signature



Verse 1:
