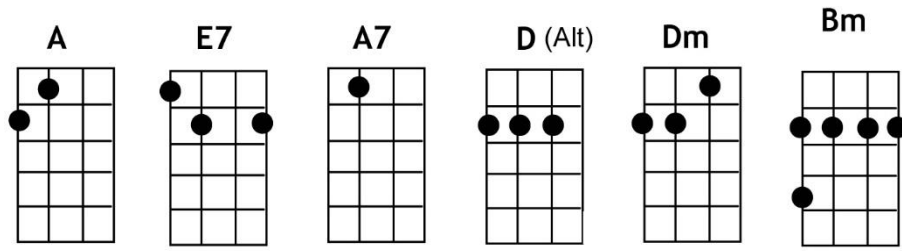


Blue Bayou
