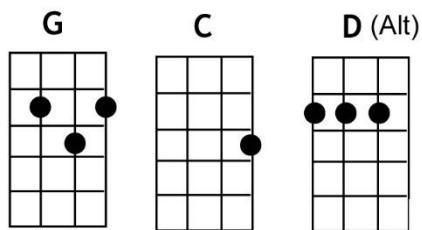


COTTON FIELDS
