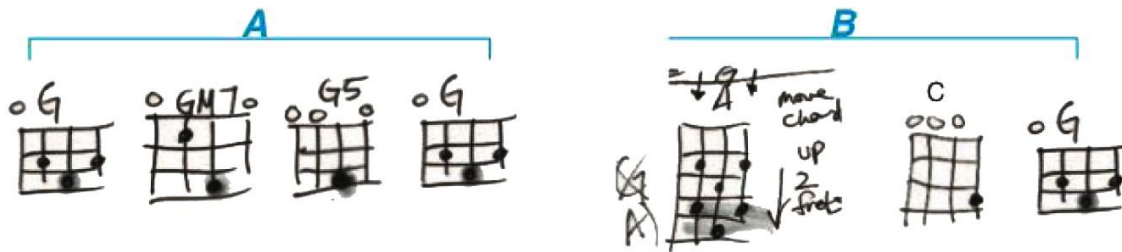


Isn't It A Pity - George Harrison
