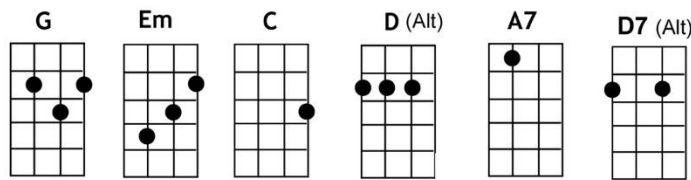

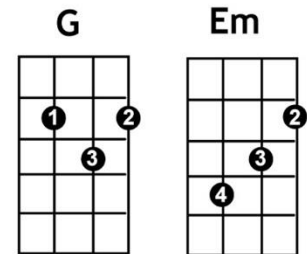


INTRO: 4 X G chord (Bob)
