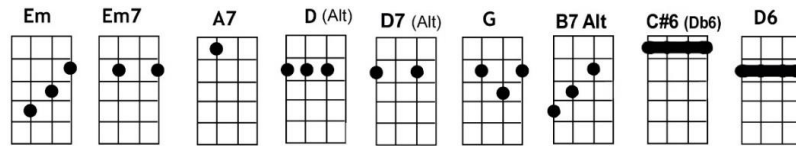


YOU'RE JUST IN LOVE - Irving Berlin

Part 1

[D] I hear singing and there's no one there.

I smell blossoms and the [A7] trees are bare.

[D] I keep tossing in my sleep at night,

And what's [D7] more I've lost my [G] appetite

[Em] Stars that [Em7] used to [A7] twinkle [D] in the [B7] skies

Are twinkling [Em7] in my eyes, [A7] I wonder [D] why? [A7]

Part 2

[D] You don't need analyzing, it is not so surprising

That you feel very strange but [A7] nice.

Your heart goes pitter patter, I know just what's the matter,

Because I've been there once or [D] twice. [A7]

[D] Put your head on my shoulder, you need someone who's older

A rubdown [D7] with a velvet [G] glove

[Em] There is nothing [Em7] you can [A7] take

[D] to relieve that [B7] pleasant ache

[Em7] You're not sick, you're [A7] just in [D] love. [A7]
